

### N3 Managers: **Important Revised Website Information**

We have a revised website for N3, this is the link for it, it will replace the one you have been used to for a number of years. This email will explain what has changed and what to look for. Please take the time to review it before or while you are looking at the revised site.

We have been using two different programs to do our website and schedule, this was necessary because one could not do both jobs. That has changed. The format will look familiar but there have been some items removed and some added. This is a summary of those changes, I urge you to review the revised site and save it to your “favorites” as the older one will no longer be used and will not be updated from its present state.

First the home page has all the sheets from the old site in addition to some new ones. You should review those on your own, however the biggest change is the rosters for all teams are now in one sheet that you can click on from the Home Page. These are the PDF sheets available from the home page:

**SSUSA Rules 2015:** we follow USSA rules first, then we follow Recreation D3 rules which take precedent over USSA, and finally N3 rules which take precedent over all other rules. This document covers USSA 2015-2016 rules

**Future Seasons Start and End Dates:** The recreation Department schedules start and end dates for all recreational softball leagues, this document has those dates listed through the year **2017**. This should aid you when planning vacations.

**By Laws:** self explanatory

**Rules Neighborhood Div. 3:** self explanatory

**Division Alignment Fall 2015** self explanatory

**Sub Duty Schedule Fall 2015** self explanatory

**Schedule Neighborhood Fall 2015:** self explanatory

**Division Standings Fall 2015:** this item is also part of the topics along the left side titled “Standings” this season is duplicated here to make it more convenient.

**Team Rosters Neighborhood Div. 3 Fall 2015:** This item lists all the team rosters in one document, there is no longer a topic along the left side that covers this.

### **The tabs along the side are different**

**Home:** this will always get you back to the home page where all the forms above are located

**Latest News:** Future use, Election info may go here?

**Team Schedules:** This item will allow you to check out any teams *remaining* schedule, so every team you look at now will not show September 12, last week’s games. There are a lot of teams listed, I cannot change that, however only the teams that are in the fall season will have data. You will have to find the appropriate team for this season. A lot of teams have more than one listing because they have played in multiple divisions, you will have to navigate to the appropriate division designation (P) for pacific if that team is in Pacific this season. They are alphabetical so they are easy to locate.

**Scores:** This tab will allow you to see the scores of this season and most all past seasons if you want to do that. They are listed with oldest season at the top, so this season is at the very bottom. When you click on this season you will see the entire season of scores listed by week with week one at the top. This is much easier to search scores than the previous website where you had to constantly go back and forth, now it is all there on one sheet after two clicks from the home page.

**Standings:** This tab works like the scores tab in that you can look at previous seasons standings, however, this seasons standings are listed on the home page in PDF for your convenience. If you do not have any desire to see a previous seasons standings you do not ever have to go to this tab. **Also this eliminates having two different formats of standings, the standings are all tie break generated.**

**Links:** There is a link to the R3 website and all other recreational Softball Leagues that have websites. If you have a site suggestion let me know. If you sign on to the N3 Website you can get to all of the recreational leagues. You should know that if you use a link to get to another site like RBL for example you need to use the back arrows if you want to get back to N3, if you just click on the "Home" button it will only bring you to the home page of whatever site you are linked to.

I have designed this so that you can get what you want most with one or two clicks with all the information you are looking for, I hope you find it better and easier to operate, it is not fancy but it does the job. I hope you agree.
