Code of Conduct

1. **Good sportsmanship is expected of everyone involved.** It is the responsibility of each coach to be familiar with the rules, policies and guidelines stated under the general playing rules of his/her particular age group and the league and relay all of this information to players and parents to help ensure that sportsmanship is followed and upheld. Coaches are to help control their parents/spectators during all league activities.
2. **Umpires shall warn coaches, parents, or spectators once on behavior.** If unsportsmanlike behavior continues or occurs again the offending person will be ejected from the game and suspended as stated in #4 below. A second ejection of a player, coach, or fan from one team in a game will result in a forfeit of the game for that team.
3. Umpires, field supervisors, or town representatives may eject players, coaches, and/or parents from any game accordance with the official rules. Reasons for ejection will include but not be limited to: the use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs, the use of profane language, derogatory remarks, fighting, or any other flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. Ejections can occur before, during, or after any game or practice. **Anyone ejected from a game will have 2 minutes to leave the facility or the team of which the offender is a member will forfeit the game.**

Anyone ejected from a game the following penalties apply:

1st Offense: Offender must sit out the next scheduled game.

2nd Offense: Offender will not be allowed back the rest of the season.
